
**RE: BLOCKADE/OVERFLOODING OF

We hereby acknowledge the receipt of your letter dated 20th March, 1999, calling us to come to the Land section of Public affairs Division, PH to collect claims form.

We hereby need to remind you that this is not a fresh case and so cannot be begun from the beginning again. We have the following as evidences that your call on us is not justifiable:

- (1) The compensation has once been estimated to a tune of N1,690,130.00.
- (2) We acknowledge you have paid some of the joint claimers but yet there are irregularities.
- (3) This irregularities show only five joint claimers acknowledged the share received from the payment made to Chief C. Ihedike.
